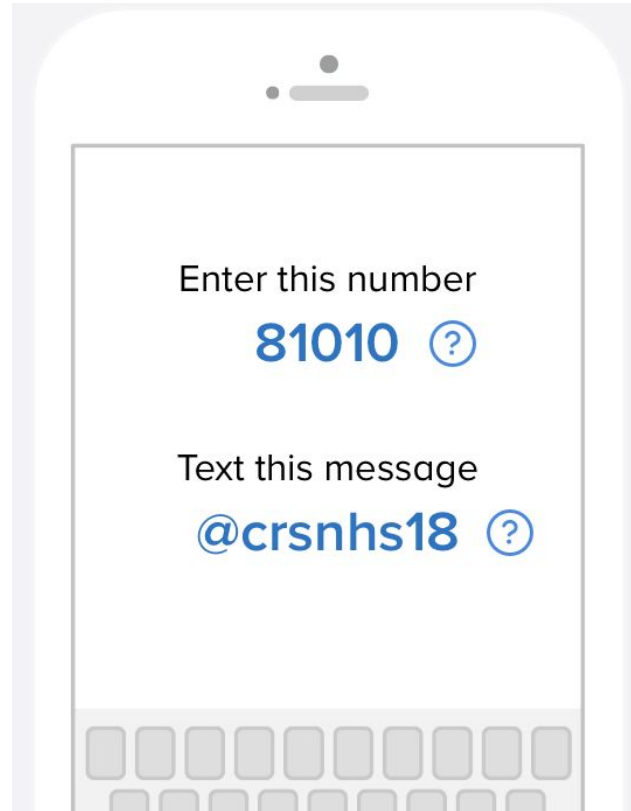

Purpose of SNHS

Requisite to Maintain Membership

- Members must keep his/her good standing and good conduct while in SNHS
